We had been dining at Pappy's Pizza , whenever I visited Anthony to help with the paper work needed for his Craftsworker Guild organization that we both belonged. so, Luckily I've left my business card for the owner during our luncheon get togethers.. So, he commissioned me to help with painting his Pappy's Family on his store windows., and trusting me even though it's my first time doing the murals. The task took me over 20 hours to sketch and paint the summer scenes per his suggested printouts. At first, I thought it was suppose to be regular people on the murals, but he corrected me with caricature sketches of the Pappy Family as it relates to his store's logo and business cards. Also, painting on glass requires at least 2 coats of paint. The quality of the paint makes a difference as I used both heavy body Liquitex and Golden paints. The others acrylic paints were too thin to adhere to the glass.
